For crops grown from seed, apply before or at seeding, or in the early season as a side dress application. For perennial crops, apply early season during the vigorous growth period. PHOSFORCE™ can be applied through various application methods including in-furrow, side-dress, on the surface, irrigation, and fertigation. Use a minimum of 2.5 gallons per acre of water and/or fertilizer carrier with application.

PHOSFORCE™ has optimal effects when placed near seed or root zone. Apply sufficient water during or after treatment to deliver PHOSFORCE™ into the root zone. Applications may benefit from using a soil wetting agent or soil surfactant.

<b>ROW CROPS</b>	Apply 8 fl oz/acre in starter applications in-furrow, 2X2 for row crops (corn, cotton, cereals, peanut, soybean, pulse crops, rice, sorghum, soybean, sugar beet, sugarcane, and sunflower). Use 8-16 fl oz/acre when using a side dress application, on the surface application, irrigation or fertigation method.
<b>POTATO AND ROOT &amp; TUBER CROPS</b>	Apply 20 fl oz/acre in starter applications in-furrow, irrigation, or in early season as side dress.
<b>HAYLAGE AND FORAGE CROPS</b>	Apply 8-20 fl oz/acre on haylage and forage crops (alfalfa and pasture).
<b>VEGETABLE CROPS</b>	Apply 20 fl oz/acre on vegetables (brassicas, cucurbits, fruiting, and leafy) at or before seeding, or apply 20 fl oz/gal immediately after transplant in a drench or through drip line.
<b>TREE AND VINE CROPS</b>	Apply 20 fl oz/100 gal water in a drench, through drip line, or by deep root feeding on tree and vine crops (fruit, grape, and berry).
<b>TURF</b>	<p><b>Warm-season turf:</b> Apply 20 fl oz/acre beginning at dormancy break.
